Duke Energy Grant Benefits ACC's Haw River Riparian Buffer and Provides Educational Opportunities

The Alamance Community College Foundation was awarded a grant to improve local water quality, quantity and conservation. The grant funded a native prairie outdoor viewing platform and is financing the restoration of a native prairie on campus land designated as flood plain. Through the creation of a native Piedmont prairie, ACC will develop an enhanced filtering system for rainwater and flood waters passing over and through this land resulting in reduced sediment and pollution into the Haw River. A prairie trail will be signposted with information about the benefits of native prairie for supporting the health of the river.

Horticulture students have sown native seeds several times but have been thwarted in establishing the prairie thus far due to ill-timed flooding. It may take a few years to get the prairie fully established.

Ornamental grasses will be planted in late spring around the observation deck. Work on paths, signage and benches will proceed as weather permits. The viewing platform and prairie will be used by ACC and ABSS faculty and students for instructional and leisure activities.

The prairie and platform will be open to the public in order to increase awareness about protecting the Haw River. It will serve as a model for those wishing to create environmentally sensitive river buffers.
