The benefit has raised \$15,000 to establish this scholarship.

In addition to being mayor of the City of Mebane for 35 years, Mayor Stephenson also served as an ACC Trustee for 20 years (1990-2010), including two years as chair. He was a member of the ACC Foundation Board of Directors from the mid-1980s through 1999, serving as president from 1989-1990.

Earlier this year, he and his wife Pat established the Stephenson Family Scholarship. The scholarship provides financial assistance to students who are Mebane residents or who graduated from Eastern Alamance High School. Preference will be given to nursing or pre-nursing students.
